The paint has not faded, cracked, used away, or scratched off at all. Also though our countertops total look remarkable and I definitely proceed to love them, they aren't ideal.

I am unsure what the reason is, however it is something that happened throughout the preliminary painting/sealing procedure. I saw the yellowing within a couple of weeks of finishing the kitchen counters as well as it hasn't become worse at all in the months and years given that. The yellowing itself is really mild.

I do, specifically versus the white array, white cabinets, and also white backsplash areas. The various other problem I have actually discovered is that there are a couple of areas where you can see light scratches on the counter top finish when the light hits it.

They are really tough to capture in an image yet ideally, you can get the idea. There might be some method to buff these scratches out, yet they are so small, I really have not looked right into it.

I recognize that seem like a lame solution, yet it holds true. Using a particular type of paint is not the key to paint counter tops so they last. I made use of a combination of remaining wall paint and also acrylic craft paint and both were wonderful. You absolutely do not require to purchase an unique kitchen counter paint package unless you truly wish to.

The paint is merely the color the sealant is the real surface that takes all of the misuse. (I utilize for practically everything since it stays with anything.) The key to the longevity of our repainted counter tops is 100% I utilized over the paint. Material is a thick clear coating that you pour on as opposed to brushing on.

Functioning with this type of pour-on surface is extra challenging than merely repainting on a leading layer and also has a little bit of an understanding curve, yet the completed appearance is so worth it.

Transforming the dated laminate without the expenditure of really changing the kitchen counters was completely worth it. And also I would likewise use the very same resin sealant. Even though it hasn't been best, it has held up incredibly well as well as just looks so darn excellent. I do, however, desire that I had added a great deal even more grey graining to my 'marble' counter tops.

The marbling of the last kitchen counters is a whole lot a lot more refined than I would have sucked as. They much more closely resemble white quartz kitchen counters than marble but considering that it's really just paint, I'm quite satisfied with that result! As a matter of fact to make points also easier, I would certainly like to attempt making use of marble call paper rather than paint.
